Brazilian Jiu Jitsu (The Gentle Art) is a grappling martial art that focuses on body movement, leverage, and submissions. This class will focus on safety, primary Jiu Jitsu positions, respect, and defensive moves with little to no submissions or joint manipulations. The Jiu Jitsu A class will consist of a warm-up, a quick explanation of a core Jiu Jitsu principle with 30 mins of instruction and training. We will end each class with a game and a quick discussion on Godly characteristics as they apply to Jiu Jitsu and life. All the movements will be done barefoot and on a mat for comfort and safety. Things to bring to class: sandals (to go to the bathroom), trimmed fingernails, athletic shorts or pants (no buttons or zippers as they may rip the mat), t-shirt or rash guard, mouth guard (optional), water bottle and a good attitude.
